The Land Use & Economic Development Working Group will help the Core Team address the following issues:

Issue to address: One important policy recommendation is to look for opportunities for activity centers that have adequate density or could have adequate density to support a more multi-modal approach on these corridors.

Issue to address: One important policy recommendation is to better connect the region. The Land Use Working Group will prepare a map of the nodes where the major transportation “drivers” exist or activity centers and where future development will occur. The map will show the important connections or key corridors and linkages.

Issue to address: Planning for transportation and for land use has been a challenge in the 5-County area. Often, there are different people or different agencies responsible for planning transportation and land use. What can help improve the coordination of land use and transportation planning between KDOT and local officials? What would that process look like?
